English - Writing

Autumn 1 - The Mousehole Cat

The dramatic and moving Cornish tale of Mowzer, the cat, and Tom, the old Fisherman, who brave the fury of the Great Storm Cat to try and save their village.

Autumn 2 - Arthur and the Golden Rope

Buried amongst the treasures in Professor Brownstone's vault, lies a humble collection of books. Filled with legendary stories from his ancestors, they tell of fearless fighters and unlikely heroes. Arthur journeys to the land of the Vikings to a place filled with magical objects and powerful gods.

Maths

Place Value - 4 digit numbers, partitioning 4 digit numbers, number lines to 1,000 and 10,000, comparing and ordering numbers, rounding to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000

Addition and Subtraction - add and subtract 1s, 10s, 100s and 1000s, add with more than 1 exchange, subtract 2 4-digit numbers with more than 1 exchange, equivalent difference, problems solving with multi steps.

Measure Area - Measure using squares, count squares, make shapes and compare area.

Multiplication and Division - Multiply and divide 3, 6, 7, and 9, 11 and 12 \times tables, multiply and divide by 1 and 0, multiply 3 numbers

PE

Orienteering - skills of map reading, team work and problem solving around the school field, forest area and playground.

Dance - performing a simple range of traditional Indian dance arm and hand gestures.

Science

Autumn 1 - changing states - Compare and group solids, liquids or gases. Observe that some materials change state when heated or cooled.

Evaporation and condensation in the water cycle.
Autumn 2 - Electricity changes - looking at circuits and exploring ways in which electricity flows.
