Maths: We will be exploring patterns and making repeated patterns. We will be comparing objects with different properties, such as size.

Phonics: We are continuing with our 'Rhyme Time' and 'Tuning into Sounds' sessions.

We will either hand out paper homework or set it on Class Dojo if it is a practical activity. Please make sure you are connected on Class Dojo to access this. If you need any support logging on to Dojo please come and see us.

Children will attend nursery in their own (old) clothes and a pair of wellies. We will then spend the majority of the session outside in our woodland area, exploring, creating and learning outdoors.
