Hello Spring! As we enter another busy term here in Nursery please find below details of our Spring Curriculum, topic information and learning focuses.

Literacy

This term we will be exploring traditional tales such as:

- ◆ Jack and the Beanstalk
- ◆ The Three Little Pigs
- ◆ Goldilocks and the Three Bears

This will then lend itself for us to enter our topic of 'Bears'. During this topic we will be reading books such as:

- Biscuit Bear
- Were going on a Bear Hunt
- This is the Bear and the Scary Night

Maths

- 5 frame focus and Subitising
- Exploring patterns around our environment and repeating patterns
- Exploring and making 2D shape pictures and introducing 3D shape
- Positional Language—Following instructions and describing position
- Ordering numbers 1-5 and number formations
- Introducing numicon
- Exploring size and length

Phonics

In Nursery we have now began to implement our school Phase 1 Phonics programme of learning. This will include a range of activities with a strong emphasis on the importance of listening and being able to tune into sounds in and around our environment. Other activities will include:

- Using musical instruments
- Body Percussion— Creating beats and exploring syllables
- Exploring rhyme and initial sounds in words
- Oral blending and word segmenting



Our wider curriculum activities this term include:

The celebration of Chinese New Year
Making character comparisons
Growing a beanstalk
Internet Safety
Adding features to maps
Exploring different weathers and landscapes e.g rivers, caves
